Phased Re-Opening of Services: Provider Survey Department of Children and Youth Affairs

The Government Roadmap for Reopening Society and Business sets out Ireland's plan for lifting COVID-19 restrictions. Plans for the phased re-opening of early learning and care and school-age childcare services is being guided by this Roadmap:

- Phase 3 (29 June), opening of crèches, childminders and pre-schools for children of essential workers in a phased manner with social distancing and other requirements applying.
- Phase 4 (20 July), opening of crèches, childminders and pre-schools for children of all other workers on a gradually increasing phased basis and slowly increasing thereafter.

Plans for re-opening will also be underpinned by the Government's Return to Work Safely Protocol, expert advice, available evidence and consultation with early learning and care and school-age childcare stakeholder representatives, providers and practitioners themselves. An Advisory Group, chaired by the Minister, has been established.

In order to inform planning, a series of surveys will be administered to parents, providers and practitioners over the coming weeks along with a call for submissions.

This is the first in a series of surveys for providers. This survey is for **providers who usually operate in July and August**. A separate survey for other providers will follow.

The data from this survey will provide critical information to the Department of Children and Youth Affairs in developing and costing plans for re-opening. Your participation in this survey is strongly encouraged and appreciated.
